Mobility overview

Do you wish you could spend less time in a traffic jam and catch a different glimpse of the city? There are alternative and efficient solutions available to you to get to Tour & Taxis.

Cycling is healthy

Do you live or work near the site? The easiest way to get to Tour&Taxis is on foot. No traffic jams, no parking problems! Tour & Taxis has a number of freely accessible outdoor bike parks. The regional "CK" cycle route runs alongside the canal, so don't hesitate to consult the Brussels cycle route map to choose the route that suits you best. TIP Do you have a preference for free floating and electric bikes? In any case, don't forget to lock up your bicycles properly on a bike parking rack on the Site or in the surrounding neighbourhood.

Train

Brussels North station can be accessed easily throughout Belgium. It is situated on less than 1km of distance to Tour & Taxis. Pick the most appropriate transport to reach your destination (bus, Tour&Taxis shuttle service, on foot, scooter, etc.). You made it!

TIP Did you know you could bring your folding bike along on the train, free of charge? The train and the folding bike are such a great combo to get to explore the city and travel to Tour & Taxis. You can put away your folding bike in one of the free available lockers.

Ever heard of carpooling?

Tired of traveling alone? Don't hesitate to try carpooling. Carpooling platforms such as Carpool or Blablacar are here to help. A low-cost, user-friendly solution that's also good for the environment!

Take the Shuttle Service

A free shuttle service is provided every weekday from 5.30 AM to 10 PM. Every 5 to 10 min, a shuttle service travels from Brussels North station (under the station) to the site of Tour & Taxis, back and forth. Get on it!

Electric vehicles

Over 100 European recharge card suppliers accepted.

- Esplanade parking (Drève Anna Boch) : 50 charging stations (- 1)
- Parklane parking (13 rue Picard) : 40 charging stations (-1)

Bike Parking

There are different availabilities to park your bicycle. Many bike parking racks are available on the site.

Do you work at Entrepôt Royal? An underground bike parking is available (70 places).
Do you work at Gare Maritime? An underground bike parking is available in the sheds (400 places).

Power up!

Would you like to power up your electric bike? Piece of cake! Go to the charging station in our bike parking!

Parking space

Tour&Taxis has two main semi-public pay parking lots. Accessible 24 hours a day, both are equipped with recharging facilities for electric cars.

Parking Esplanade - Drève Anna Boch (Avenue du Port 88) - 1000 Brussels
Parking Park Lane - Rue Picard 13 - 1000 Brussels
(3€/h or 22€/day)

Avoid a fine if you park on the street.
Tour&Taxis is located in a paid "yellow" parking zone from Monday to Saturday.

Car sharing

Car sharing service provided at the Tour & Taxis site

Two Cambio cars are available in front of Royal Depot at the side of the Havenlaan. To be able to book the cars, you need to simply register through the cambio website www.cambio.be, and have a car at your disposal any time. Convenient for all trips in and out of town.

Two spots are reserved for Poppy cars at the entrance of the site. It can come in pretty handy when cruising through the city or getting to a professional meeting.

Electric step scooters

Self service electric step and scooters are available in Brussels and are very convenient. Kick-start your step scooter from a subway station or a train station till you've reached your destination. Don't forget to park your scooter near a bike parking, as not to obstruct the passage of any passersby.
